**Registration Date:** April 13-15

**Age Requirement:** Children must be five years old **before** July 1, 2021 to register for Kindergarten.

### **Documents that are REQUIRED to register:**

Proof of residency such as driver's license or utility bill that shows current address

• Child's original birth certificate

Immunization records to date

• Custody Papers, if applicable

## The Pennsylvania State Health Law requires each child entering school for the first time to have the following immunizations before school begins:

- Diphtheria and Tetanus, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, and Varicella (Chicken Pox Vaccine)
- Children will need a physical and dental exam before entering Kindergarten.

### **Registration Process**

The Kindergarten registration process includes three steps:

**1. Spring Information: February 25, 2021 Sugarcreek Elementary & February 26, 2021 Chicora Elementary** The Spring information event is an opportunity to learn about Sugarcreek Elementary/Chicora Elementary and the Kindergarten program. #### 2. Kindergarten Registration: April 13-15, 2021

**3. Kindergarten Orientation:** Before school starts, parents and children will be invited to Kindergarten Orientation. This allows your child to get over those "first day jitters" before starting school. They will meet the teachers, go through lunch procedures, and even go for a bus ride! At this time, parents can meet the teachers, ask any last minute questions, and discuss transportation arrangements.
